- Involve your whole church—children can draw welcome banners or make cards, you can bring thoughtful giveaways or goodie bags with tags expressing your church's love for the men and women at the Bridge. The sky's the limit!

What you'll be doing:

Serving as our greeting team, doing room setup and tear-down, providing and serving a meal, and childcare (toys and supplies will be provided) ... it's all easy stuff and anybody can do it.

Details:

- All meetings are Tuesdays, at 1443 Roosevelt, Chicago, IL 60608 at The Meeting Place. The team should arrive between 6:30-6:45pm to pray and be trained. They will be finished by 9:30pm.

- The Meeting Place has a sink, oven, and refrigerator. It's in the same room with the meeting, so we ask that Host Teams do not prep meals during the service. Please keep your meals easy to set-up in a few minutes after the service. There is a Jewel and Costco 1 block away.
- This is a one-night commitment only. Some teams come back if the opportunity fits their passions, but no additional commitment is required.
